> COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2078

1 AN ACT TO ENACT THE MISSISSIPPI MILITARY MEMORIAL PROTECTION 2 ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ALTERATION OF CERTAIN HISTORICAL MONUMENTS AND 3 MEMORIALS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. (1) None of the following items, structures or areas may be relocated, removed, disturbed, altered, renamed or 6 rededicated: Any Revolutionary War, War of 1812, Mexican-American 7 8 War, War Between the States, Spanish-American War, World War I, 9 World War II, Korean War, Vietnam War, Persian Gulf War, War in Iraq or Native American War's statutes, monuments, memorials or 10 nameplates (plaques), which have been erected on public property 11 12 of the state or any of its political subdivisions, such as local, 13 municipal or county owned public areas, and any statutes, monuments, memorials, nameplates (plaques), schools, streets, 14 15 bridges, buildings, parks preserves, reserves or other public items, structure or areas of the state or any of its political 16 subdivisions, such as, local, municipal or county owned public 17 18 areas, which has been dedicated in memory of, or named for, any historical military figure, historical military event, military 19 20 organization or military unit.

(2) No person may prevent the public body responsible for maintaining any of the items, structures or areas described above from taking proper measures and exercising proper means for the protection, preservation, care, repair or restoration of those items, structures or areas.

(3) This section shall not apply to items, structures orareas located on property owned or acquired by the Mississippi
