SENATE BILL NO. 2086

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-53-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 ALLOW THE OWNER OF EACH DOG OR CAT TO PURCHASE THE RABIES VACCINE 2 3 FROM A LICENSED VETERINARIAN AND TO VACCINATE THE DOG OR CAT, 4 UNLESS THE VETERINARIAN FINDS THE OWNER IS NOT COMPETENT; TO AMEND SECTION 41-53-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; 5 6 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 41-53-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 9 10 41-53-5. All inoculations (vaccinations) done in accordance with this chapter must be done by either a licensed veterinarian 11 or other competent person granted a permit to administer virus 12 (vaccine) by the State Board of Health. However, the owner of 13 each dog or cat may purchase the rabies virus (vaccine) from a 14 licensed veterinarian and may inoculate (vaccinate) the dog or 15 cat, unless the veterinarian finds that the owner is not competent 16 17 to do so. If the veterinarian does not sell the virus (vaccine) to the owner because he finds that the owner is incompetent, 18 then the veterinarian shall report to the Department of Health his 19 20 finding, including the name and address of the owner, and his 21 reasons therefor. 22 SECTION 2. Section 41-53-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 23 24 41-53-9. All persons administering virus (vaccine) in accordance with this chapter shall furnish the owner of each dog 25 or cat inoculated (vaccinated) a certificate of inoculation 26 27 (vaccination) for each dog or cat inoculated (vaccinated) indicating the breed of each dog or cat inoculated (vaccinated), 28 the sex of each dog or cat inoculated (vaccinated), and the 29 *SS01/R4.1* S. markings and the serial number of the tag attached to the collar 30 31 or some other device on each dog. Persons administering virus 32 (vaccine) in accordance with this chapter shall maintain records 33 of each inoculation, indicating the owner of each dog or cat 34 inoculated (vaccinated), the breed of each dog or cat inoculated 35 (vaccinated), the sex of each dog or cat inoculated (vaccinated), and the markings and serial number of the tag furnished to the 36 owner of each dog. If the virus (vaccine) is administered by the 37 owner of the dog or cat, then the licensed veterinarian who 38 furnished the virus (vaccine) shall maintain records of each virus 39 40 (vaccine) dispensed, indicating the owner of each dog or cat to be inoculated (vaccinated), the breed of each dog or cat to be 41 42 inoculated (vaccinated), and the markings and serial number of the tag furnished to the owner of each dog. 43 44 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004. 45
