## SENATE BILL NO. 2145

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 1 LICENSE TAGS HONORING ELVIS PRESLEY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a 5 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon 6 7 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes 8 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 9 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount 10 provided in subsection (3), shall be issued a special license tag 11 for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such 12 person as a fan of Elvis Presley. The distinctive license tags so 13 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 14 15 Commission may prescribe, and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 16 17 tag.

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 18 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 19 20 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 21 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 22 23 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional 24 25 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 26 county general fund.

27 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) 28 after July 1, 2004, any person applying for a distinctive license 29 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 30 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 31 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 32 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 33 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 34 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 35 36 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 37 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 38 39 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 40 collector.

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 59 (d) 60 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 61 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section 62 27-19-44.2.

63 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 64 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 65 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 66 this section. The tax collector shall issue month and year decals 67 for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which 68 69 will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 70 (6)71 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 72 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 73 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 74 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 75 76 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 77 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 78 distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this 79 80 section.

This act shall take effect and be in force from SECTION 2. 81 and after July 1, 2004. 82
