6	SECTION 1. Section 25-55-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	25-55-25. $\underline{(1)}$ A duplicate for a lost or destroyed
9	bond * * * shall not issue until there shall have been filed with
10	the officer an affidavit and a bond. The affidavit must be that
11	of some credible person knowing the facts, and it must set forth
12	the ownership of such bond * * *, the number of unpaid coupons, if
13	any, thereto attached, and the description thereof, embracing, if
14	can be, its number, to whom and for what issued, its date, and
15	when mature. The bond must be that of a person to whom the
16	duplicate is to be issued, with at least two (2) sufficient
17	sureties, in a sum equal to double the amount of the lost,
18	destroyed or stolen bond * * *, payable to the state, conditioned
19	to pay all damages which the state, county, city, town, or levee
20	board, as the case may be, may sustain if compelled to pay such
21	bond or coupons * * *, together with all costs and expenses and
22	lawyers' fees, if any, incurred in enforcing the bond.
23	(2) A duplicate for a lost or destroyed warrant shall not
24	issue until there shall have been filed with the officer an
