SENATE BILL NO. 2391

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 71-3-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 DECLARE THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW SHALL BE FAIRLY, IMPARTIALLY AND EVEN-HANDEDLY CONSTRUED IN SUCH A MANNER THAT NO PARTY IS FAVORED; 2 3 4 5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 71-3-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 71-3-1. This chapter shall be known and cited as "Workers' Compensation Law, " and shall be administered by the Workers' 10 Compensation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the 11 "commission," cooperating with other state and federal authorities 12 for the prevention of injuries and occupational diseases to 13 14 workers and, in event of injury or occupational disease, their rehabilitation or restoration to health and vocational 15 16 opportunity; and this chapter shall be fairly construed according 17 to the law and the evidence. It is the specific intention of the Legislature that the 18 19 Workers' Compensation Law shall be fairly, impartially and even-handedly construed in such a manner that no party to any 20 21 workers' compensation proceeding is favored and that all evidence 22 shall be fairly and impartially construed in such a manner that no 23 fact-finding by the commission shall favor any party in any proceeding under this chapter. Any violation of this legislative 24 mandate shall constitute a lack of substantial evidence with 25 regard to fact-findings of the commission and shall constitute 26 27 reversible error as a matter of law.

Wherever used in this chapter, or in any other statute or 28 rule or regulation affecting the former Workmen's Compensation Law 29 and any of its functions or duties: 30 31 (a) The words "workmen's compensation" shall mean 32 "workers' compensation"; and 33 (b) The word "commission" shall mean the Workers' 34 Compensation Commission. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after July 1, 2004. 36
