1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-43, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY DONATE TO THE STATEWIDE LITTER PREVENTION FUND TO BE EXPENDED AS APPROVED BY KEEP MISSISSIPPI BEAUTIFUL WHEN THE PERSON RECEIVES HIS REGULAR DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 63-1-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	63-1-43. (1) The fee for receiving the application and
10	issuing the regular driver's or operator's license and the fee for
11	renewing the license shall be:
12	(a) Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) plus the applicable
13	photograph fee for each applicant for a four-year license;
14	(b) Three Dollars (\$3.00) plus the applicable
15	photograph fee for each applicant for a one-year license, except
16	as provided in paragraph (c) of this subsection; and
17	(c) Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the applicable
18	photograph fee for a one-year license for each applicant who is
19	not a United States citizen and who does not possess a social
20	security number issued by the United States government.
21	(d) In addition to the fees required in paragraph (a)
22	of this section, an applicant may contribute an additional One
23	Dollar (\$1.00) which shall be deposited into the Statewide Litter
24	Prevention Fund. The applicant shall be informed that he may
25	contribute an additional One Dollar (\$1.00) which shall be
26	deposited into the Statewide Litter Prevention Fund and shall be
27	expended solely for the purpose of funding litter prevention

projects or litter education program, as recommended by the

- All originals and renewals of regular operators' licenses 31
- 32 shall be in compliance with Section 63-1-47.
- 33 The fee for receiving the application and issuing a
- 34 motorcycle endorsement shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00). Motorcycle
- endorsements shall be valid for the same period of time as the 35
- applicant's operator's license. 36
- The fee for receiving the application and issuing a 37
- 38 restricted motorcycle operator's license and the fee for renewing
- 39 such license shall be:
- (a) Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) plus the applicable 40
- 41 photograph fee for a four-year license; and
- Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the applicable 42 (b)
- photograph fee for a one (1) year license. 43
- All originals and renewals of restricted motorcycle licenses 44
- 45 shall be valid for the same period of time that an original

- 48 (4) From and after January 1, 1990, every person who makes
- application for an original license or a renewal license to 49
- 50 operate a vehicle as a common carrier by motor vehicle, taxicab,
- passenger coach, dray, contract carrier or private commercial 51
- carrier as such terms are defined in Section 27-19-3, except for 52
- 53 those vehicles for which a Class A, B or C license is required
- under Article 2 of this chapter, shall, in lieu of the regular 54
- 55 driver's license above provided for, apply for and obtain a Class
- D commercial driver's license. Except as otherwise provided in 56

- Except as otherwise provided in subsection (5) of this
- 65 section, all originals and renewals of commercial licenses issued
- 66 under this section shall be valid for a period of four (4) years,
- 67 in compliance with Section 63-1-47. Only persons who operate the
- 68 above-mentioned vehicles in the course of the regular and
- 69 customary business of the owner shall be required to obtain a
- 70 Class D commercial operator's license, and persons operating such
- 71 vehicles for private purposes or in emergencies shall not be
- 72 required to obtain such license.
- 73 (5) The original and each renewal of a commercial driver's
- 74 license issued under this section to a person who is not a United
- 75 States citizen and who does not possess a social security number
- 76 issued by the United States government shall be issued for a
- 77 period of one (1) year for a fee of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the
- 78 applicable photograph fee and shall expire one (1) year from the
- 79 date of issuance. Such person may renew a commercial license
- 80 issued under this section within thirty (30) days of expiration of
- 81 the license.
- 82 (6) The Commissioner of Public Safety, by rule or
- 83 regulation, shall establish a driver's license photograph fee
- 84 which shall be the actual cost of the photograph rounded off to
- 85 the next highest dollar. Monies collected for the photograph fee
- 86 shall be deposited into a special photograph fee account which the
- 87 Department of Public Safety shall use to pay the actual cost of
- 88 producing the photographs. Any monies collected in excess of the
- 89 actual costs of the photography shall be deposited to the General
- 90 Fund of the State of Mississippi.
- 91 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 92 and after July 1, 2004.
