- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-3-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF PEACE OFFICER TO INCLUDE SPECIAL AND
- 3 SENIOR STATUS JUDGES WITH THE RESULT THAT MURDER OF SUCH PERSON
- 4 ACTING IN HIS OFFICIAL CAPACITY OR BY REASON OF AN ACT PERFORMED
- 5 IN HIS OFFICIAL CAPACITY WILL CONSTITUTE A CAPITAL OFFENSE; AND
- 6 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-3-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 97-3-19. (1) The killing of a human being without the
- 11 authority of law by any means or in any manner shall be murder in
- 12 the following cases:
- 13 (a) When done with deliberate design to effect the
- 14 death of the person killed, or of any human being;
- 15 (b) When done in the commission of an act eminently
- 16 dangerous to others and evincing a depraved heart, regardless of
- 17 human life, although without any premeditated design to effect the
- 18 death of any particular individual;
- 19 (c) When done without any design to effect death by any
- 20 person engaged in the commission of any felony other than rape,
- 21 kidnapping, burglary, arson, robbery, sexual battery, unnatural
- 22 intercourse with any child under the age of twelve (12), or
- 23 nonconsensual unnatural intercourse with mankind, or felonious
- 24 abuse and/or battery of a child in violation of subsection (2) of
- 25 Section 97-5-39, or in any attempt to commit such felonies.
- 26 (2) The killing of a human being without the authority of
- 27 law by any means or in any manner shall be capital murder in the
- 28 following cases:

30 officer or fireman while such officer or fireman is acting in his 31 official capacity or by reason of an act performed in his official capacity, and with knowledge that the victim was a peace officer 32 33 or fireman. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "peace 34 officer" means any state or federal law enforcement officer, 35 including, but not limited to, a federal park ranger, the sheriff of or police officer of a city or town, a conservation officer, a 36 parole officer, a judge, senior status judge, special judge, 37 prosecuting attorney or any other court official, an agent of the 38 39 Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of the State Tax Commission,

Murder which is perpetrated by killing a peace

- an agent of the Bureau of Narcotics, personnel of the Mississippi 40
- Highway Patrol, and the employees of the Department of Corrections 41
- who are designated as peace officers by the Commissioner of 42

a bomb or explosive device;

- When done with or without any design to effect 54

- 71 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
