2	TO REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE PAID FOR DISTINCTIVE FIRE FIGHTER
3	MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-19-56.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 27-19-56.1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a fire
- 8 fighter, including a career fire fighter, a volunteer fire fighter
- 9 or an industrial fire fighter, employed by or in the service of
- 10 any municipality, county, fire district, state agency or industry
- 11 in the state who is a resident of this state, or who is a retired
- 12 fire fighter who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the
- 13 road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration
- 14 fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers,
- 15 pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon
- 16 payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection
- 17 (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for
- 18 each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person
- 19 as a fire fighter or retired fire fighter. The distinctive
- 20 license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be
- 21 agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Fire
- 22 Fighters Association and the State Tax Commission, shall consist
- 23 of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
- 24 distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the
- 25 State Tax Commission, display the county name.
- 26 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 27 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms

- 28 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such
- 29 distinctive license tags (a) shall present to the issuing official
- 30 proof of their employment or service as a fire fighter by
- 31 presentation of the applicant's official fire fighter
- 32 identification card or a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 33 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 34 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry by or for
- 35 whom the applicant is employed or serves as a fire fighter; or (b)
- 36 shall present proof that they are a retired fire fighter by
- 37 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 38 governing authority or chief executive officer of the
- 39 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry from whom
- 40 the fire fighter retired. The application and the additional fee
- 41 imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three percent
- 42 (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 43 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 44 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee
- 45 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county
- 46 general fund.
- 47 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 48 after July 1, 1992, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 49 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 51 applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all
- 52 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 53 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 54 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 55 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 56 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 57 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 58 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 59 license tag, or if the owner resigns from or otherwise vacates his

- 60 employment or service as a fire fighter, he must surrender it to
- 61 the local county tax collector.
- 62 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 63 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 64 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 65 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of
- 66 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an
- 67 amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees
- 68 collected for each such distinctive license tag issued under this
- 69 section to the State General Fund, and the remainder of such
- 70 additional fees collected shall be distributed by the State
- 71 Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 72 7-9-70.
- 73 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 74 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 75 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 76 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 77 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 78 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 79 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 80 tag.
- 81 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 82 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 83 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 84 Section 27-19-37, Mississippi Code of 1972. The fee for a
- 85 replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
- 86 The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall
- 87 be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund
- 88 five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and
- 89 the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds
- 90 from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under
- 91 this section.

92	(7) In lieu of the distinctive license tag authorized under
93	subsections (1) through (6) of this section, any person who
94	presents proof of his employment or service as a fire fighter in
95	the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section, may be
96	issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor vehicle
97	registered in his name identifying such person as a fire fighter.
98	The distinctive license tag decal shall be of such size, color and
99	design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the
100	Mississippi Fire Fighters Association and the State Tax
101	Commission; however, the State Tax Commission shall have final
102	approval of the size, color and design. The distinctive license
103	tag decals shall be prepared and sold at Two Dollars (\$2.00) each
104	through the Mississippi Fire Fighters Training Academy.
105	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
106	and after July 1, 2004.
