SENATE BILL NO. 2457

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-3-137, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2	CLARIFY THAT THE REQUIREMENT UNDER SECTION 65-1-8, MISSISSIPPI
3	CODE OF 1972, THAT CERTAIN SMALL MUNICIPALITIES SHALL NOT BEAR THE
4	COST OF UTILITY RELOCATION FROM THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF STATE HIGHWAY
5	AND THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL BEAR THE COST IF
6	UTILITY RELOCATION APPLIES TO CERTAIN PROJECTS; AND FOR RELATED
7	PURPOSES.
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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. Section 65-3-137, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 65-3-137. SECTION 1. (1) The following highway is 11
- designated as a state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction 12
- of the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and 13
- maintenance when the City of Flowood provides necessary 14
- 15 rights-of-way, including utility adjustments and relocations:
- Central District Rankin County: 16
- 17 Mississippi 468 - That two-lane portion of Mississippi
- 18 468 (Flowood Drive) beginning at Fourth Street in
- Flowood and extending northeasterly to Mississippi 19
- 20 Highway 475, a distance of approximately two and
- two-tenths (2.2) miles. 21
- 22 The segment described in subsection (1) of this section
- 23 shall be a four-lane facility built to the design standards of the
- 24 Mississippi Department of Transportation.
- (3) The requirements under Section 65-1-8 related to the 25
- cost and expense of removal and relocation of utilities in the 26
- rights-of-way of state highways in municipalities with a 27
- 28 population of ten thousand (10,000) or less shall apply to this
- 29 section.

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- 30 SECTION 2. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
- 31 shall number, maintain, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
- 32 following described highway segment, subject to the conditions
- 33 prescribed in subsection (2) of this section.
- 34 Central District Rankin County:
- West Rankin Parkway (New Route) Beginning at
- 36 Mississippi 25 in the City of Flowood, thence south to
- 37 U.S. 80 at Pearson Road in the City of Pearl, all in
- 38 Rankin County.
- 39 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation may
- 40 construct the highway segment described in subsection (1) of this
- 41 section as a four-lane facility in accordance with current design
- 42 standards; however, the City of Flowood, the City of Pearl, Rankin
- 43 County and any private corporation jointly shall provide necessary
- 44 engineering and rights-of-way, including utility adjustments and
- 45 relocations.
- 46 (3) The requirements under Section 65-1-8 related to the
- 47 cost and expense of removal and relocation of utilities in the
- 48 rights-of-way of state highways in municipalities with a
- 49 population of ten thousand (10,000) or less shall apply to this
- 50 section.
- 51 SECTION 3. The following highway is designated as a state
- 52 highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 53 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
- 54 such highway, together with the highways designated in Section
- 55 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to the designated state
- 56 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
- 57 Mississippi:
- 58 Southern District Jones County:
- 59 Mississippi 590 Beginning at Mississippi 11 and
- extending easterly to Mississippi 29, a distance of
- approximately 1.3 miles.

62 SECTION 4. (1) The following highway is designated as a 63 state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the 64 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and 65 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to 66 67 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of Mississippi: 68 69 Central District - Newton County: 70 Decatur Street beginning on the north side of the intersection of Third Street and Decatur Street, and 71 72 proceeding northward to the beginning of state 73 maintenance south of U.S. Highway 80, all within the 74 City of Newton. 75 The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall (2) 76 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the 77 highway designated in subsection (1) of this section in the same 78 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in 79 Sections 65-1-75, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. However, the City of Newton shall not be required to provide to the Mississippi Department of 80 81 Transportation any right-of-way with a width any greater than the width of right-of-way that existed at the time that the highway 82 83 segment described in subsection (1) of this section was returned to the jurisdiction of the City of Newton. 84 85 SECTION 5. The following highways are deleted from the state 86 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the 87 88 governing authorities of the City of Newton: Central District - Newton County: 89 90 That section of old Mississippi 15 beginning south (a) of Interstate 20 at the intersection of old Mississippi 91 92 15 and present Mississippi 15 and extending 93 southwesterly for approximately .033 miles, all within

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the City of Newton; and

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- 95 (b) That section of old Mississippi 15 located
- 96 between U.S. Highway 80 and Decatur Street, all
- 97 within the City of Newton.
- 98 SECTION 6. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
- 99 may construct to department design standards, may perform such
- 100 reconstruction as may be required to existing highways and may
- 101 acquire by gift, purchase or eminent domain proceedings such
- 102 property as may be necessary to provide four (4) lanes for traffic
- 103 on and along the following location:
- 104 Central District Lauderdale County:
- 105 Old U.S. Highway 45 beginning in the City of Meridian at
- or near the old Coca Cola Company and extending
- northerly approximately two (2) miles to just beyond the
- 108 Town of Marion.
- 109 (2) Lauderdale County, the City of Meridian and the Town of
- 110 Marion shall provide required right-of-way, remove all
- 111 encroachments and bring up to Transportation Department standards
- 112 existing roads and bridges along the route described in subsection
- 113 (1) of this section.
- 114 (3) The mileage of highway specifically designated in
- 115 subsection (1) of this section shall be under the jurisdiction of
- 116 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
- 117 maintenance and, together with the highways designated in Section
- 118 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to the state designated
- 119 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
- 120 Mississippi.
- 121 SECTION 7. (1) (a) That portion of Mississippi Highway 25
- 122 from south of Becker, Mississippi, to the Monroe/Itawamba County
- 123 line shall be known as the "Monroe County Parkway."
- 124 (b) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
- 125 erect and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching that
- 126 portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in this subsection.

- 127 (2) The portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in
 128 subsection (1) of this section shall be constructed by the
 129 Mississippi Department of Transportation as a fully controlled
 130 access road. The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
 131 authorized to landscape the right-of-way of the portion of
 132 Mississippi Highway 25 described in subsection (1) of this
- 134 (3) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect any
 135 advertisement or advertising structure within one thousand (1,000)
 136 feet of the right-of-way of the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
 137 described in subsection (1) of this section. This subsection
 138 shall not apply to areas located within a municipality or to
 139 signs, displays or devices located on a building which carry only
 140 advertisements strictly related to the lawful use of the building.
- (4) Mississippi Highway 25 shall intersect with U.S. Highway 278 at least five hundred (500) feet west of the eastern city limits of the City of Amory as such city limits existed on January 144 1, 2000.
- 145 (5) The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
 146 authorized to construct a four-lane connector road at a point at
 147 or near the northern city limits of the City of Amory between old
 148 Mississippi Highway 25 and the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
 149 described in subsection (1) of this section.
- 150 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 151 and after its passage.
