1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 62, (HOUSE BILL NO. 1540), LAWS OF 2003, BY REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY FROM THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 62, (House Bill No. 1540), Laws of 2003,
7	is amended to read as follows:
8	Section 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
10	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
11	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History
12	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
13	June 30, 2004\$ 8,503,195.00.
14	Section 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
15	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
16	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
17	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
18	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
19	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
20	year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
21	\$ <u>2,774,413.00</u> .
22	Section 3. With funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

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    act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
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         Section 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and
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    History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant,
    donation or contribution from any individual, public or private
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    organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the
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    operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or
    contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and

63	manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.	
64	Section 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the	
65	Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge th	ie
66	maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent wit	.h
67	the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from t	hese
68	charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the	
69	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of	
70	Archives and History.	
71	Section 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no p	art
72	of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used	for
73	the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the Sta	ite
74	Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.	
75	Section 7. In addition to all other sums herein	
76	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
77	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Lo	cal
78	Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the co	st
79	of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, ar	ıd

124	and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in
125	House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the
126	preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

L27	Section 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
L28	Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept,
L29	budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand
L30	Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
L31	the credit of the New Capitol Repair and Renovation Fund created
L32	in Section 27-19-56.69 (8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
L33	purpose of paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New
L34	Capitol, in accordance with rules and regulations of the
L35	Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
L36	with the escalation of federal funds.
L37	Section 10. Of the funds provided under the provisions of
L38	this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00)is
L39	provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating
L <b>4</b> 0	Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only
L <b>4</b> 1	President of the Confederate States of America.

L43	Section 12. In addition to all other sums herein
L44	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L45	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the Budget Contingency
L46	Fund, as created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972,
L <b>4</b> 7	to the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of
L48	supporting the Statewide Oral History Project for the fiscal year
L49	beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
L50	\$ 50,000.00.
L51	Section 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
L52	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
L53	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
L54	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
L55	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
L56	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
L57	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
L58	and after its passage.
