## SENATE BILL NO. 2550

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-31-10, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
  TO ALLOW A DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO SUPPLEMENT THE SALARY OF A
  CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR FROM OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS AS COMPENSATION
- 3 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR FROM OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS AS COMPENSATION 4 FOR ADDITIONAL WORK DONE OUTSIDE THE REGULAR DUTIES OF A FULL-TIME
- 5 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-31-10, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 25-31-10. (1) Any district attorney may appoint a full-time
- 10 criminal investigator.
- 11 (2) The district attorneys of the Third, Fifth, Ninth,
- 12 Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth and
- 13 Twentieth Circuit Court Districts may appoint one (1) additional
- 14 full-time criminal investigator for a total of two (2) full-time
- 15 criminal investigators.
- 16 (3) The district attorneys of the First, Second, Fourth and
- 17 Seventh and Nineteenth Circuit Court Districts may appoint two (2)
- 18 additional full-time criminal investigators for a total of three
- 19 (3) full-time criminal investigators.
- 20 (4) No district attorney or assistant district attorney
- 21 shall accept any private employment, civil or criminal, in any
- 22 matter investigated by such criminal investigators.
- 23 (5) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this
- 24 subsection (5), the full and complete compensation for all public
- 25 duties rendered by <u>full-time</u> criminal investigators shall be not
- 26 more than Fifty-four Thousand Dollars (\$54,000.00) per annum, to
- 27 be determined at the discretion of the district attorney based
- 28 upon the qualifications, education and experience of the criminal

- 29 investigator, plus necessary travel and other expenses, to be paid
- 30 in accordance with Section 25-31-8.
- 31 (b) (i) \* \* \* The maximum salary under this
- 32 subsection (5) for a criminal investigator who has a law degree
- 33 may be supplemented by the district attorney from other available
- 34 funds, but not to exceed the maximum salary for a legal assistant
- 35 to a district attorney.
- 36 (ii) The maximum salary under this subsection (5) for a
- 37 criminal investigator who administers a pretrial intervention
- 38 program may be supplemented by the district attorney from other
- 39 available funds, but not to exceed an additional Seven Hundred
- 40 Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) per month.
- 41 (6) Any criminal investigator may be designated by the
- 42 district attorney to attend the Law Enforcement Officers Training
- 43 Program set forth in Section 45-6-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of
- 44 1972. The total expenses associated with attendance by criminal
- 45 investigators at the Law Enforcement Officers Training Program
- 46 shall be paid out of the funds of the appropriate district
- 47 attorney.
- 48 (7) This section shall stand repealed from and after January
- 49 1, 2007.
- 50 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after its passage.
