10	(a) To establish the general policy of the department;
11	(b) To approve proposals for the location of new
12	facilities, for major renovation activities, and for the creation
13	of new programs and divisions within the department as well as for
14	the abolition of the same; provided, however, that the
15	commissioner shall approve the location of no new facility unless
16	the board of supervisors of the county or the governing
17	authorities of the municipality in which the new facility is to be
18	located shall have had the opportunity with at least sixty (60)
19	days' prior notice to disapprove the location of the proposed
20	facility. If either the board of supervisors or the governing
21	authorities shall disapprove the facility, it shall not be located
22	in that county or municipality. Said notice shall be made by
23	certified mail, return receipt requested, to the members of the
24	board or governing authorities and to the clerk thereof;
25	(c) Except as otherwise provided or required by law, to
26	open bids and approve the sale of any products or manufactured

29	rules and regulations established by the State Fiscal Management
30	Board; * * *
31	(d) To transfer, in his discretion, employees of the
32	department to any other facility of the department; and
33	(e) To adopt administrative rules and regulations
34	including, but not limited to, offender transfer procedures, award
35	of administrative earned time, personnel procedures, transfer of
36	employees between facilities and employment practices.
