- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Earlene Williams of Tate County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction of the crime of false pretense in 1988 in Tate County,
- 8 Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the
- 9 custody of the Department of Corrections. Her sentence was
- 10 suspended and she was placed on probation for three (3) years.
- 11 Her probation was terminated on February 24, 1992. Since that
- 12 time she has conducted herself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 13 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after its passage.
