## SENATE BILL NO. 2639

AN ACT TO ENACT A "MISSISSIPPI LIVING ORGAN DONOR LEAVE ACT" 1 2 WHICH PROVIDES FOR EXTENDED LEAVE TIME FOR STATE EMPLOYEES WHO 3 MAKE A LIVING ORGAN OR BONE MARROW DONATION; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) This act may be cited as the "Mississippi 6 7 Organ Donor Leave Act." (2) This act is intended to provide time off with pay for 8 9 state employees who donate an organ, bone marrow, blood or blood 10 platelets. (3) As used in this act: 11 "Agency" means any branch, department, board, 12 (a) committee or commission of state government, but does not include 13 units of local government or school districts. 14 (b) "Department" means the Mississippi Department of 15 16 Finance and Administration. 17 (C) "Participating employee" means a permanent full-time or part-time employee who has been employed by an agency 18 for a period of six (6) months or more and who donates an organ, 19 bone marrow, blood or blood platelets. 20 21 (4) (a) On request, a participating employee subject to this act may be entitled to organ donation leave with pay. 22 23 (b) An employee may use (i) up to thirty (30) days of organ donation leave in any twelve-month period to serve as a bone 24 marrow donor, (ii) up to thirty (30) days of organ donation leave 25 26 in any twelve-month period to serve as an organ donor, (iii) up to one (1) hour to donate blood every fifty-six (56) days, and (iv) 27 up to two (2) hours to donate blood platelets in accordance with 28 \*SS02/R1009\* S. 29 appropriate medical standards established by the American Red 30 Cross or other nationally recognized standards. Leave under 31 subparagraph (iv) may not be granted more than twenty-four (24) 32 times in a twelve-month period.

33 (c) An employee may use organ donation leave or other
34 leave authorized in paragraph (b) of this section only after
35 obtaining approval from the employee's agency.

36 (d) An employee shall not be required to use
37 accumulated sick or vacation leave time before being eligible for
38 organ donor leave.

(e) The department must adopt rules governing organ donation leave, including rules that (i) establish conditions and procedures for requesting and approving leave, and (ii) require medical documentation of the proposed organ or bone marrow donation before leave is approved by the employing agency. **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
