7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.56, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	27-19-56.56. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
11	member of the Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Mississippi, Free and
12	Accepted Ancient Yorkrite Masons, or the wife or unmarried
13	daughter of a member of the Prince Hall Grand Lodge of
14	Mississippi, Free and Accepted Ancient Yorkrite Masons, upon
15	complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and
16	licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and
17	bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
18	prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
19	trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
20	an additional annual fee in the amount provided in subsection (3)
21	of this section, shall be entitled to a special license tag which
22	displays the Prince Hall Grand Lodge Mason emblem and displays the
23	letters "F&AAYM." The tags shall be of such color and design as
24	the State Tax Commission shall prescribe subject to the approval
25	of the Mississippi License Tag Commission.
26	(2) Application for the special license tags authorized by
27	this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms

- 31 Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Mississippi as prescribed by the State
- 32 Tax Commission showing their membership in the Free and Accepted
- 33 Ancient Yorkrite Masons, Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Mississippi,
- 34 or documentation as prescribed by the State Tax Commission showing
- 35 that they are the wife or unmarried daughter of a member of the
- 36 Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Mississippi, Free and Accepted Ancient
- 37 Yorkrite Masons. The application and the additional fee imposed
- 38 under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00)
- 39 thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to

- 41 commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax
- 42 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- 43 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 44 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 45 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 46 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 47 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 48 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 49 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 50 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 51 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 52 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of

- 73 deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended
- 74 solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or reconstruction

- 76 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 77 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 78 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 79 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 80 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 81 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 82 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 83 tag.
- 84 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 85 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 86 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 87 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 88 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 89 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 90 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 91 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 92 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 93 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

94 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 95 and after July 1, 2004.
