AN ACT TO ENACT THE "WILLIAM LEWIS LOVETT HUNTER SAFETY ACT"; 1 2 TO REQUIRE A HUNTER TO USE A LIGHT WHEN LEAVING A HUNTING AREA ON 3 FOOT AFTER LEGAL HUNTING HOURS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. This act shall be known as and may be cited as 5 б the "William Lewis Lovett Hunter Safety Act." 7 SECTION 2. Any person who is hunting shall use a light when leaving a hunting area on foot after legal hunting hours. 8

9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from10 and after July 1, 2004.
