SENATE BILL NO. 2675

1 AN ACT TO ENACT THE "WILLIAM LEWIS LOVETT HUNTER SAFETY ACT";
2 TO REQUIRE A HUNTER TO USE A LIGHT WHEN LEAVING A HUNTING AREA ON
3 FOOT AFTER LEGAL HUNTING HOURS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known as and may be cited as
6 the "William Lewis Lovett Hunter Safety Act."

7 **SECTION 2.** Any person who is hunting shall use a light when
8 leaving a hunting area on foot after legal hunting hours.

9 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
10 and after July 1, 2004.
