- AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF BLACK CREEK IN
 LAMAR, FORREST, PERRY, STONE, GEORGE AND JACKSON COUNTIES, AS A
 STATE SCENIC STREAM AND TO INCLUDE THE STREAM IN THE STATE SCENIC
 STREAMS STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Black Creek in Lamar, Forrest, Perry, Stone,
- 7 George and Jackson Counties from Mississippi Highway 589 in Lamar
- 8 County to its confluence with the Pascagoula River, which was
- 9 designated as eligible for nomination under Section 51-4-17, is
- 10 designated as a state scenic stream and is included in the
- 11 Mississippi Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after its passage.
