SENATE BILL NO. 2725

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF BLACK CREEK IN
2 LAMAR, FORREST, PERRY, STONE, GEORGE AND JACKSON COUNTIES, AS A
3 STATE SCENIC STREAM AND TO INCLUDE THE STREAM IN THE STATE SCENIC
4 STREAMS STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Black Creek in Lamar, Forrest, Perry, Stone,
7 George and Jackson Counties from Mississippi Highway 589 in Lamar
8 County to its confluence with the Pascagoula River, which was
9 designated as eligible for nomination under Section 51-4-17, is
10 designated as a state scenic stream and is included in the
11 Mississippi Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
