SENATE BILL NO. 2727

1 AN ACT TO CREATE CODE SECTION 51-4-21.3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF  
2 1972, TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE PASCAGOULA RIVER IN  
3 GEORGE AND JACKSON COUNTIES AS ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION TO THE  
4 STATE SCENIC STREAMS STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED  
5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section  
8 51-4-21.3, Mississippi Code of 1972:

9 51-4-21.3. In accordance with Section 51-4-7, the Pascagoula  
10 River from the confluence of the Chickasawhay and Leaf Rivers in  
11 George County to its mouth in Jackson County is designated as  
12 eligible for nomination to the state Scenic Streams Stewardship  
13 Program.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
15 and after its passage.
