6	SECTION 1. Section 99-19-73, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

L27	(7) If a fine or other penalty imposed is suspended, in
L28	whole or in part, such suspension shall not affect the state
L29	assessment under this section. No state assessment imposed under
L30	the provisions of this section may be suspended or reduced by the

L32	(8) After a determination by the court of the amount due, it
L33	shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly collect
L34	all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this
L35	section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of
L36	this section may not be paid by personal check. It shall be the
L37	duty of the chancery clerk of each county to deposit all such
L38	state assessments collected in the circuit, county and justice
L39	courts in such county on a monthly basis with the State Treasurer
L40	pursuant to appropriate procedures established by the State
L 4 1	Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly lump-sum deposit
L42	of the total state assessments collected in the circuit, county
L43	and justice courts in such county under this section, and shall
L44	report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total
L45	number of violations under each subsection for which state
L46	assessments were collected in the circuit, county and justice
L47	courts in such county during such month. It shall be the duty of
L48	the municipal clerk of each municipality to deposit all such state
L49	assessments collected in the municipal court in such municipality
L50	on a monthly basis with the State Treasurer pursuant to
L51	appropriate procedures established by the State Auditor. The
L52	municipal clerk shall make a monthly lump-sum deposit of the total
L53	state assessments collected in the municipal court in such
L54	municipality under this section, and shall report to the
L55	Department of Finance and Administration the total number of
L56	violations under each subsection for which state assessments were
L57	collected in the municipal court in such municipality during such
L58	month.

- It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and 159 Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all such state 160 assessments into the proper special fund in the State Treasury. 161 162 The monthly deposit shall be based upon the number of violations 163 reported under each subsection and the pro rata amount of such 164 assessment due to the appropriate special fund. The Department of 165 Finance and Administration shall issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these special funds. 166
- 167 (10) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds 168 169 associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is 170 171 reversed. The Auditor shall provide in such regulations for certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the 172 defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court 173 174 order or abstract by which such defendant is entitled to a refund. All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with 175 176 the procedures established by the Auditor.
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- 178 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 179 and after July 1, 2004.
