SENATE BILL NO. 2795

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-53-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO REVISE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A SOCIAL WORKER LICENSE TO PROVIDE 3 THAT PERSONS WHO HAVE A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY, 4 SOCIOLOGY, NURSING OR CRIMINAL JUSTICE FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LICENSE; AND FOR RELATED 5 6 PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 73-53-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 10 73-53-13. The board shall issue the appropriate license to applicants who meet the qualifications of this section. 11 (a) Prerequisites - "social worker": A license as a 12 13 "social worker" shall be issued to an applicant who meets the following qualifications: 14 (i) Has a baccalaureate degree in social work from 15 a college or university accredited by the Council on Social Work 16 Education or Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, or has 17 a baccalaureate degree in psychology, sociology, nursing or 18 criminal justice from an accredited college or university, and has 19 20 satisfactorily completed an examination for this license; or (ii) Has a comparable license or registration from 21 22 another state or territory of the United States that imposes qualifications substantially similar to those of this chapter. 23 Prerequisites - "master social worker": A license 24 (b) as a "master social worker" shall be issued to an applicant who 25 meets the following qualifications: 26 27 (i) Has a doctorate or master's degree from a school of social work accredited by the Council on Social Work 28 29 Education; and *SS06/R1197* S. 30 (ii) Has satisfactorily completed an examination 31 for his license; or Has a comparable license or registration 32 (iii) 33 from another state or territory of the United States that imposes 34 qualifications substantially similar to those of this chapter. Prerequisites - "certified social worker": A 35 (C) license as a "certified social worker" shall be issued to an 36 applicant who meets the following qualifications: 37 (i) Is licensed under this section as a "master 38 social worker"; and 39 40 (ii) Has twenty-four (24) months of experience 41 acceptable to the board, under appropriate supervision; and 42 (iii) Has satisfactorily completed a state examination for this license; or 43 44 (iv) Has a comparable license or registration from another state or territory of the United States that imposes 45 46 qualifications substantially similar to those of this chapter. 47 (d) In addition to the above qualifications, an applicant for any of the above licenses must prove to the board's 48 49 satisfaction: Age of at least twenty-one (21) years, and 50 (i) 51 (ii) Good moral character, which is a continuing requirement for licensure, and 52 (iii) United States citizenship or status as a 53 54 legal resident alien, and (iv) Absence of conviction of a felony related to 55 the practice of social work for the last ten (10) years, and 56 (v) That the applicant has not been declared 57 mentally incompetent by any court, and if any such decree has ever 58 59 been rendered, that the decree has since been changed, and 60 (vi) Freedom from dependency on alcohol or drugs.
