- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 9 provides that a driver must decrease speed at intersections,
- 10 curves, hillcrests, on narrow or winding roads or when special
- 11 hazards exist, and that all trucks, or truck-trailer combinations
- 12 and passenger buses must reduce speed to forty-five (45) miles per
- 13 hour during inclement weather, is repealed.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after its passage.
