SENATE BILL NO. 2798

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 63-3-505, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 WHICH PROVIDES THAT A DRIVER MUST DECREASE SPEED AT INTERSECTIONS,
3 CURVES, HILLCRESTS, ON NARROW OR WINDING ROADS OR WHEN SPECIAL
4 HAZARDS EXIST, AND THAT ALL TRUCKS, OR TRUCK-TRAILER COMBINATIONS
5 AND PASSENGER BUSES MUST REDUCE SPEED TO 45 MILES PER HOUR DURING
6 INCLEMENT WEATHER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
9 provides that a driver must decrease speed at intersections,
10 curves, hillcrests, on narrow or winding roads or when special
11 hazards exist, and that all trucks, or truck-trailer combinations
12 and passenger buses must reduce speed to forty-five (45) miles per
13 hour during inclement weather, is repealed.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
