## SENATE BILL NO. 2817

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.55, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
2	1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE FEE FOR DISTINCTIVE LICENSE
3	TAGS FOR RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL
4	SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL
5	RETIRED TROOPERS ASSOCIATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-19-56.55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 27-19-56.55. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
- 10 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol and who is
- 11 a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge
- 12 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 13 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 14 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- 15 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
- 16 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor
- 17 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
- 18 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol. The
- 19 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and
- 20 design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist
- 21 of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
- 22 distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the
- 23 State Tax Commission, display the county name.
- 24 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 25 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- 26 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such
- 27 distinctive license tags shall present proof that they are a
- 28 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol by

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- 29 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 30 Commissioner of Public Safety. The application and the additional
- 31 fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars
- 32 (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 33 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 34 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee
- 35 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county
- 36 general fund.
- 37 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 38 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 39 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 40 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 41 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 42 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 43 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 44 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 45 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 46 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 47 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 48 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 49 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
- 50 collector.
- 51 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 52 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 53 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected
- 54 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute
- 55 such collections as follows:
- 56 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
- 57 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 58 section shall be distributed to the Mississippi Highway Safety
- 59 Patrol Retired Troopers Association.
- (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall

- 62 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
- 63 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 64 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
- 65 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 66 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 67 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 68 reconstruction of highways.
- (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- 70 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 71 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 72 27-19-44.2.
- 73 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 74 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 75 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 76 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 77 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 78 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 79 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 80 tag.
- 81 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 82 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 83 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 84 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 85 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 86 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 87 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 88 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 89 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 90 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 91 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 92 and after July 1, 2004.
