AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-7-64, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT PERSONS UNDER AGE 16 FROM OPERATING OR RIDING UPON ANY 3 MOTORCYCLE, MOTOR SCOOTER OR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE UPON ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THIS STATE UNLESS SUCH PERSON IS WEARING A CRASH HELMET; TO PROHIBIT PERSONS AGES 16 TO 18 FROM OPERATING OR RIDING UPON ANY MOTORCYCLE OR MOTOR SCOOTER UPON ANY PUBLIC ROAD 7 OR HIGHWAY OF THIS STATE UNLESS SUCH PERSON IS WEARING A CRASH 8 HELMET; TO CORRECT THE REFERENCE TO THE ENTITY APPROVING MOTORCYCLE CRASH HELMET STANDARDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 11 SECTION 1. Section 63-7-64, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 12 63-7-64. (1) No person under sixteen (16) years of age may 13 operate or ride upon any motorcycle, motor scooter or all-terrain 14 15 vehicle upon any public or private property in this state unless 16 such person is wearing on his or her head a crash helmet that complies with minimum guidelines established by the National 17 Highway Traffic Safety Administration pursuant to the National 18 Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 for helmets designed 19 for use by motorcyclists. 20 21 (2) No person who is at least sixteen (16) years of age but who is under eighteen (18) years of age may operate or ride upon 22 23 any motorcycle or motor scooter upon the public roads or highways 24 of this state unless such person is wearing on his or her head a 25 crash helmet that complies with minimum guidelines established by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration pursuant to the 26

National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 for helmets

29	(3) Violation of this section shall be deemed a violation of
30	the traffic regulations and rules of the road and punishable as
31	provided by Section 63-9-11.
32	(4) For the purposes of this section, the term "all-terrain
33	vehicle" means any motorized vehicle manufactured and designed
34	exclusively for off-road use that is fifty (50) inches or less in
35	width, has an unladen dry weight of six hundred (600) pounds or

less, travels on three (3), four (4) or more low pressure tires,

- has a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and uses
