6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> $(1)$ (a) In consideration for the conveyance of
7	property authorized in subsection (2) of this section, the
8	Mississippi Transportation Commission may transfer and convey to
9	the Itawamba Community College District all right, title and
10	interest in certain real property located in Itawamba County,
11	Mississippi, such property described more particularly as follows:
12	Itawamba County MDOT Maintenance Headquarters located
13	at 800 West Main Street, Fulton, Mississippi,
14	consisting of approximately 3 acres.
15	(b) The conveyance authorized in this subsection (1)
16	may be subject to additional terms and conditions agreed upon by
17	the Mississippi Transportation Commission and the Board of
18	Trustees of the Itawamba Community College District.
19	(2) (a) In consideration for the conveyance of property
20	authorized in subsection (1) of this section, the Board of
21	Trustees of the Itawamba Community College District, may transfer
22	and convey to the Mississippi Transportation Commission all right,
23	title and interest in certain real property located in Itawamba
24	County, Mississippi, such property described more particularly as
25	follows:
26	Approximately 3 acres located at the south corner of
27	the intersection of 101 Max Place Road and the Access
28	Road in Fulton, Mississippi.

29	(b) The conveyance authorized in this subsection (2)
30	may be subject to additional terms and conditions agreed upon by
31	the Board of Trustees of the Itawamba Community College District
