- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 49-7-47. (1) The commission may control, regulate and 6
- 7 manage the taking of all alligators and common snapping turtles.
- 8 (2) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to purchase
- 9 a combination hunting and fishing license to hunt, kill or catch
- any alligator or common snapping turtle for sporting purposes. 10
- (3) Residents and nonresidents shall be required to obtain a 11
- special permit to hunt, kill, catch or possess any alligator or 12
- common snapping turtle for commercial purposes. The commission 13
- may establish a reasonable fee for an annual special sporting 14
- permit, not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and may 15
- prescribe regulations governing commercial trade in alligators and 16
- common snapping turtles. Any reasonable fee established for an 17
- annual special commercial permit shall not exceed Five Hundred 18
- Dollars (\$500.00). Such permit shall be good from the date of its 19
- 20 issuance to June 30 following its date.
- (4) Any person violating this section is guilty, upon 21
- 22 conviction, of a Class I offense and is punishable as provided in
- 23 Section 49-7-141.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24
- 25 and after its passage.
