SENATE BILL NO. 2908

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DISTINCTIVE MOTOR 1 2 VEHICLE LICENSE TAG TO SUPPORTERS OF THE DELTA WATERFOWL FOUNDATION; TO PROVIDE THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH TAG; AND 3 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 6 SECTION 1. 7 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 8 9 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 10 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 11 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 12 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 13 supporter of the Delta Waterfowl Foundation. The distinctive 14 license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the 15 16 State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Delta Waterfowl 17 Foundation, may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 18 19 tag.

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 20 (2) 21 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 22 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 23 24 Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 25 26 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county 27 28 general fund.

29 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) 30 after July 1, 2004, any person applying for a distinctive license 31 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 32 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 33 34 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 35 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 36 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 37 38 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 39 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 40 41 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 42 collector.

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected
under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute
such collections as follows:

48 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
49 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
50 section shall be distributed to the Delta Waterfowl Foundation.

51 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 52 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 53 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn 54 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

55 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee 56 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this 57 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund 58 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or 59 reconstruction of highways.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 64 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 65 66 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 67 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 68 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 69 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 70 71 tag.

72 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 73 74 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 75 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 76 77 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 78 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 79 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 80 81 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

82 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 83 and after July 1, 2004.
