## SENATE BILL NO. 2978

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-57-108, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT THE BORROWING AUTHORITY OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THE 2 3 EVENT OF LOCAL REVENUE SHORTFALL ALSO APPLIES TO REDUCTIONS IN ANTICIPATED ALLOCATIONS IN ADEQUATE EDUCATION PROGRAM ALLOTMENTS 4 OR EDUCATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-57-108, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8

37-57-108. In the event that the amount of revenue collected 9 or estimated to be collected from local sources, on behalf of a 10 school district during a fiscal year, is less than the amount 11 provided for in the duly adopted budget of said school district 12 for the fiscal year, or in the event that the amount of state 13 14 funds received for adequate education program allotments, education enhancement funds, or other funds appropriated by the 15 Mississippi Legislature, are less than the school district's 16 entitlement of the appropriated amount due to reductions in 17 allocations, as certified by the State Department of Education, 18 19 then the school district may issue promissory notes in an amount and in the manner set forth in Section 27-39-333, not to exceed 20 21 the estimated shortfall of revenue from the respective state or 22 local sources, but in no event to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) 23 of its budget anticipated to be funded from the respective sources of the shortfall for the fiscal year. A school district issuing 24 notes under the provisions of this section shall not be required 25 to publish notice of its intention to do so or to secure the 26 27 consent of the qualified electors or the tax levying authority of 28 such school district.
