1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-705, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ABOLISH THE MULTI-MODAL FUND COMMITTEE AND TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PORT MULTI-MODAL FUND COMMITTEE; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-707, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE 5% DISCRETIONARY DISTRIBUTION OF MULTI-MODAL FUNDS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; TO DELETE DISCRETIONARY MULTIYEAR COMMITMENT TO FUNDING; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-709, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE MULTI-MODAL FUND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE; TO REPEAL SECTION 65-1-711, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE REPEAL OF THE MULTI-MODAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
13	SECTION 1. Section 65-1-705, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
14	amended as follows:

16	(1) (a) There is hereby created the Port Multi-Modal Fund

There is hereby created the Railroad Multi-Modal 48 (3) (a) Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of: 49 50 (i) The director of each railroad, or his 51 designee; 52 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his designee; and 53 54 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his 55 designee. A majority of the membership of the committee shall 56 (b) 57 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and 58 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not 59 later than August 1 of each fiscal year. 60 61 (4) (a) There is hereby created the Public Transit 62 Multi-Modal Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of:

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Three (3) directors of transit systems, other 63 (i) 64 than the Coast Transit Authority and the City of Jackson Transit 65 System serving the greater Jackson urbanized area, appointed by 66 the President of the Mississippi Public Transit Association, or 67 their designees; 68 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his 69 designee; and 70 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his designee. 71 A majority of the membership of the committee shall 72 (b) 73 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and 74 75 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not later than August 1 of each fiscal year. 76 77 SECTION 2. Section 65-1-707, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 78 amended as follows: 79 65-1-707. (1) During each state fiscal year, MDOT shall 80 distribute \* \* \* the money in the fund among the various modes as follows: 81 82 Thirty-eight percent (38%) shall be distributed to (a) 83 ports; 84 (b) Thirty-four percent (34%) shall be distributed to 85 airports; 86 (C) Sixteen percent (16%) shall be distributed to 87 transit systems; and (d) Twelve percent (12%) shall be distributed to 88 89 railroads. 90 In order for a port to receive money allocated under 91 (2) subsection (1) of this section, the port shall file an application 92 93 with MDOT describing how the funds will be used and shall provide 94 such other information as MDOT may require. 102 (a) Directly related to dredging, capital improvements
103 or the rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and

In order for an airport to receive money allocated under 110 (3) subsection (1) of this section, the airport shall file an 111 112 application with MDOT describing how the funds will be used and 113 shall provide such other information as MDOT may require. Such applications shall be reviewed by the Airport Multi-Modal Fund 114 115 Committee. The Airport Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for 116 117 each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall consider appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall 118 119 be approved or funds distributed pursuant to this article unless 120 the expenditure of such funds shall be:

(a) Directly related to capital improvements or the
rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and not for
routine maintenance, administrative or operational expenses;

(b) For a project or use directly related to theoperation of the airport in its modal role; and

Such 132 applications shall be reviewed by the Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee. The Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide 133 which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for 134 each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall 135 136 consider appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall be approved or funds distributed pursuant to this article unless 137 138 the expenditure of such funds shall be:

139 (a) Directly related to capital improvements or the
140 rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and not for
141 routine maintenance, administrative or operational expenses;

(b) For a project or use directly related to theoperation of the railroad in its modal role; and

144 (c) For a purpose outside the normal operating budget145 of the railroad.

(5) (a) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for
transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be
distributed by MDOT to Coast Transit Authority.

(b) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for
transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be
distributed by MDOT to the City of Jackson Transit System serving
the greater Jackson urbanized area.

The remainder of the money allocated for transit 153 (C) 154 systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed 155 by MDOT among other transit systems. In order to receive funds under subsection (1) of this section, any such transit system 156 157 shall file an application with MDOT describing how the money will 158 be used and shall provide such other information as MDOT may 159 require. 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Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall consider appropriate.

165 (6) As a condition for the receipt of any funds distributed 166 under this section, the port, airport, railroad or transit system shall be required to fund, from public or private sources, not 167 more than ten percent (10%) of the total cost of the project or 168 169 purpose for which the funds are to be spent. The percentage amount of such matching fund requirement shall be determined by 170 171 In addition to such other contributions and expenditures as MDOT. may be considered acceptable by MDOT, in-kind contributions and 172 173 expenditures for the following shall be credited toward the above 174 matching requirement:

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(a) Pre-construction studies, planning and design;

176 (b) Personal property acquisition;

177 (c) Real property acquisition, reclamation and related178 relocation costs;

(d) Professional services; and

180 (e) Construction.

181 (7) In addition to such other expenditures as may be deemed 182 appropriate by MDOT or hereunder, money distributed from the fund 183 may be used to meet federal matching fund requirements and for 184 pre-construction studies, planning and design; personal property 185 acquisition; real property acquisition, reclamation and related 186 relocation costs; professional services; and construction.

188 SECTION 3. Section 65-1-709, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 189 amended as follows:

190 65-1-709. (1) There is hereby created the Joint Legislative 191 Multi-Modal Fund Committee which shall consist of \* \* \* the 192 Chairman of the Senate Highways and Transportation Committee, or 193 his designee; the Chairman of the Senate Ports and Marine S. 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194 Resources Committee, or his designee; \* \* \* the Chairman of the 195 House Transportation Committee, or his designee; <u>and</u> the Chairman 196 of the House <u>Ports, Harbors and Airports</u> Committee, or his 197 designee \* \* \*. Administration of this article shall be subject 198 to oversight by the Joint Legislative Multi-Modal Fund Committee.

199 (2) MDOT shall annually prepare at its expense a written 200 report on administration of the fund \* \* \* which shall include, without limitation, a description of all applications for funding 201 202 received under this article, the status of each application, the criteria used to evaluate such application, and an analysis of the 203 204 return and benefits from funding projects under this 205 article \* \* \*. MDOT shall consult with the committees established 206 in Section 65-1-705 when preparing such report and provide 207 sufficient copies of the report at no cost to such committees. MDOT shall submit such report to the Joint Legislative Multi-Modal 208 209 Fund Committee by not later than September 1 of each year.

210 **SECTION 4.** Section 65-1-711, which provides for the repeal 211 of Sections 65-1-701 through 65-1-709 establishing the Multi-Modal 212 Transportation Improvement Program, is hereby repealed.

213 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 214 and after July 1, 2004.
