SENATE BILL NO. 3017

1 AN ACT TO ENACT A STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS ON CERTAIN TYPES OF
2 CONSENT AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO BY PUBLIC AND QUASI-PUBLIC
3 ENTITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The entry of a consent agreement regarding any
6 allegation of civil or criminal wrongdoing in an enforcement
7 action of any sort by any state authority or agency or other
8 public or quasi-public entity, whether pending or having been
9 concluded, shall be subject to expiration upon a fixed period of
10 time, not to exceed seven (7) years, whether or not so expressed
11 in the terms of the consent agreement, but only to the extent that
12 the consent agreement obligates the subject of the enforcement
13 action to either do or refrain from doing any action relative to
14 the practice of a profession requiring a license issued under the
15 authority of the State of Mississippi or running for public
16 office. From and after July 1, 2004, every agreement subject to
17 the provisions of this section shall be construed to comply with
18 this section regardless of the actual date of the agreement.

19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after July 1, 2004.
