| 7 | 49-7-90. Any person who takes or possesses a paddlefish $\underline{\text{or}}$ |
| 8 | parts thereof, whether coming from within or from outside the |
| 9 | state, in violation of law or who commits waste by discarding any |
| 10 | parts of <u>a paddlefish</u> into the waters of this state <u>during the</u> |
| 11 | closed season, is guilty of a Class I violation and may be |
| 12 | punished as provided in Section 49-7-141. During the closed |
| 13 | season, a person may possess lawfully taken and processed |
| 14 | paddlefish eggs obtained from a licensed wholesale and retail |
| 15 | outlet. |
| 16 | SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from |
