SENATE BILL NO. 3097  
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF GENERAL AND  
2 SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -  
3 DIVISION OF MEDICAID FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums heretofore  
6 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of  
9 the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year  
10 ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 11,100,000.00.

11 **SECTION 2.** In addition to all other sums heretofore  
12 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
14 Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office - Division of  
15 Medicaid, which is comprised of special source funds collected by  
16 or otherwise available to the division, for the purpose of  
17 defraying the expenses of the division, for the fiscal year ending  
18 June 30, 2004..... \$ 225,000,000.00.

19 **SECTION 3.** In addition to all other sums heretofore  
20 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
21 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Budget  
22 Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code  
23 of 1972, not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of the  
24 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year  
25 ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 38,900,000.00.

26           **SECTION 4.** This additional appropriation is made for the  
27 purpose of funding the medical and administrative services  
28 provided by the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid.

29           **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds  
31 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal  
32 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
33 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers  
34 in the manner provided by law.

35           **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
36 and after its passage.
