AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 STATE TREASURER'S OFFICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 5 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the 6 7 expenses of the office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal year 8 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 9\$ 570,000.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 10 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the special fund entitled Abandoned Property Fund in the State Treasury for 12 the purpose of defraying expenses of the State Treasurer in 13 administering the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property and 14 15 certain other expenses of the office, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 16 17\$ 1,925,859.00. Based on data provided by the 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 37 38 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. In addition to all other sums herein 48 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 49 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Education Improvement Trust Fund No. 50 51 3219 for the purpose of investing funds for the fiscal year 52 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... 53\$ 87,000.00. 54 SECTION 5. who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree, 127 128 computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the 129 130 event of any such payment, then the official or person approving 131 and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and 132 severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or 133 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General; 134 provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person 135 136 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this 137 provision shall not apply.

SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 138 139 Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting 140 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such 141 142 records shall be in the same format and level of details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of 143 144 the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 145 146 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 147

148 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 149 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 150 151 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 152 153 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 154 and after July 1, 2004. 155
