1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
7	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
9	Department of Information Technology Services, for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
11	\$ 31,554,898.00
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 144
16	Part Time0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time 2
18	Part Time0
19	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
20	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
21	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
22	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
23	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
24	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
25	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
26	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
27	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

- 28 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 29 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 30 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 31 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 32 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 33 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 43 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 54 **SECTION 3.** In order to offset the cost of publishing the
- 55 annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi
- 56 Department of Information Technology Services is hereby
- 57 authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer
- 58 for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory,
- 59 to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The

- 60 contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite
- 61 periods not to exceed two (2) years.
- It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of
- 63 Information Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising
- 64 shall be used, to approve all proposed advertising submitted for
- 65 use within such annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory.
- 66 The department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in
- 67 its discretion, to reject any and all bids submitted, and if all
- 68 bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a contract within
- 69 the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of any
- 70 such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the
- 71 comparable terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. No
- 72 sectarian, un-American, political, partisan or immoral
- 73 advertisement, as determined solely by the authority or its
- 74 successor, shall be accepted.
- 75 All monies derived from sale of such advertising shall be
- 76 deposited in the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to
- 77 the credit of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology
- 78 Services.
- 79 **SECTION 4.** The Mississippi Department of Information
- 80 Technology Services is hereby authorized to receive additional
- 81 funds from any state agency or other source, including one hundred
- 82 percent (100%) general-fund agencies, for the purpose of providing
- 83 data processing or telecommunications services to any governmental
- 84 organization contracting with the Mississippi Department of
- 85 Information Technology Services for such services. The
- 86 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is
- 87 further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One Million
- 88 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty
- 89 (20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions
- 90 listed in this act in order to provide the required data
- 91 processing or telecommunications services for such governmental

- 92 organizations, under the rules and regulations of the Department
- 93 of Finance and Administration.
- 94 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 95 Department of Information Technology Services shall maintain
- 96 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 97 expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this
- 98 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
- 99 details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the
- 100 intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal
- 101 Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
- 102 Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format
- 103 and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget
- 104 request process.
- 105 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 106 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 107 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 108 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 109 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 110 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 111 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 112 and after July 1, 2004.
