AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI 1 BUREAU OF NARCOTICS OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY 2 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the 8 expenses of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, created by Section 41-29-101 et seq., 9 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 9,765,382.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the 14 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of 15 16 Public Safety which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and 17 18 maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 1,211,594.00. 19 20 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 21 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 22 Full Time..... 184 23 Permanent: Part Time..... 24 0 25 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 1

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 27 28 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 29 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 30 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 31 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 32 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 33 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 34 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 35 36 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 37 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 38 39 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 40 41 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 42 43 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 45 46 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 47 48 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 50 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 51 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 52 53 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 54 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 55 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 56 57 appropriated level.

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being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of thisact and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

62 SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 63 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 64 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 65 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 66 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 67 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

79 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 80 Section 2, funds may be expended to defray the costs of clothing 81 for sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One 82 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.

83 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 84 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 85 86 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 88 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 90 and after July 1, 2004.
