31 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 34 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 39 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 42 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 43 44 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 45 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 46 47 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 48 49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 50 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

66 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the following sum shall be derived from money in the 67 Unemployment Trust Fund, made available to this state under 68 Section 903(d) of the Social Security Act, as amended, to the 69 70 Employment Security Commission to be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund for use by the Employment Security 71 72 Commission, to administer the Unemployment Compensation (UC) law and its public employment service (ES) offices to include 73 74 purchases, modification, and automation of computer related systems and related costs; and under the direction of the Office 75 76 of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management to acquire lands 77 and construct buildings thereon or improve existing buildings to be used as offices, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, 78 79 and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 53,000,000.00.

The funds authorized in this Section shall be requisitioned by the Employment Security Commission from the Unemployment Trust Fund maintained by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States as needed for the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and such monies shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 71-5-457, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in this act, a total of 87 Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) is provided for the 88 purpose of constructing and/or lease purchasing a new headquarters 89 90 facility for the Mississippi Employment Security Commission, and 91 paying for any costs associated with the construction of The funds authorized in this section shall be under 92 facilities. *SS05/A671* S. 95 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 96 97 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98 99 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 100 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 101 and after July 1, 2004. 102
