36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 41 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 48 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 50 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 53 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

71 SECTION 3. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 72 73 necessary is appropriated out of any funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road Construction, which 74 75 is comprised of special funds to the office, for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges on the state's 76 77 county roads for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004 and ending 78 June 30, 2005.....\$ 35,000,000.00.

79 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 4. 80 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 82 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 83 84 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 85 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004. 86
