5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
7	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road				
8	Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of				
9	the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi				
10	Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning

36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 48 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 50 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 53 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

71 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 72 73 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 74 75 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 76 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 77 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 78 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 79 80 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 81 Mississippi State Legislature."

82 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete 83 84 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 85 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 86 87 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 88 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 89 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 90 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 91 92 SECTION 5. expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 94 95 (\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi 96 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses 97 incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for 98 administering and providing engineering services to political 99 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code 100 of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 101 102 consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads 103 104 Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State 105 Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending 106 June 30, 2005.

107 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to 108 109 reimburse Walthall County in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) from unobligated State Aid funds 110 111 allocated to Walthall County for the 2004-2007 term of office of members of the board of supervisors for expenditures made by 112 113 Walthall County to match funds of the United States Army Corps of 114 Engineers for the project known as Dillon's Bridge, Bogue Chitto 115 River, Walthall County.

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 116 117 act, it is the intent of the Legislature that One Hundred Sixty 118 Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) shall be expended for replacement and/or rehabilitation of a certain bridge over Hatchie Creek in 119 120 Tippah County for providing access to a civil war battle site, 121 which bridge project shall be administered by the Office of State Aid Road Construction as provided under Chapter 37 of Title 65, 122 Mississippi Code of 1972; however, such bridge shall be performed 123 124 according to specifications adopted and approved by the county 125 engineer and the Board of Supervisors of Tippah County.

129 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 130 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to 131 accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) 132 for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges 133 134 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as 135 136 established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth 137 138 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the State Fiscal Officer. 139

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 140 agency shall provide a report reflecting Fiscal Year 2004 usage of 141 wireless communication devices which shall include cellular 142 143 phones, two-way radios, pagers, or any other means of wireless communications to the Chairman of the House Appropriations 144 145 Committee, the Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, and the State Auditor by September 1, 2004. The report shall 146 147 contain, but not be limited to, the following:

148 (1) The number of wireless communication devices provided to149 employees by the agency;

150 (2) The annual cost of usage of wireless communication 151 devices by each employee of the agency who is issued a wireless 152 communication device;

(3) Separate justification of the usage of wireless communication devices by those employees issued wireless communication devices; and

156 (4) To determine whether quantifiable benefits are157 associated with the utilization of wireless communications and

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SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 160 161 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 162 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 163 164 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 165 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 166 and after July 1, 2004. 167
