SENATE BILL NO. 3192

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DESOTO 1 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO ASSIST OLIVE BRANCH, MISSISSIPPI, THE 2 3 STATE OF TENNESSEE AND OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES LOCATED IN 4 TENNESSEE, TO IMPROVE STATELINE ROAD AND REMOVE ALL SAFETY HAZARDS THAT AFFECT STATELINE ROAD; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 5 TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS WITH REGARD TO STATELINE ROAD; AND FOR 6 7 RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County, 9 10 Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to take any action that it considers necessary to assist Olive 11 Branch, Mississippi, the State of Tennessee and other governmental 12 entities located in Tennessee, to improve Stateline Road and 13 14 remove safety hazards that affect Stateline Road. 15 (2) The Board of Supervisors of DeSoto County, Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to: 16 17 (a) Resurface or realign Stateline Road including the parts of the road that are located in Tennessee; 18 19 (b) Do any work it considers necessary within the 20 right-of-way of Stateline Road including the parts of the 21 right-of-way that are located in Tennessee; 22 (c) Remove any safety hazard or contribute funds for 23 the removal of any safety hazard on the right-of-way of Stateline 24 Road that is located in Tennessee or that is located in Tennessee adjacent to the right-of-way of Stateline Road if: 25 (i) The board of supervisors deems the condition 26 27 to be dangerous; 28 (ii) The State of Tennessee, Shelby County, Tennessee or Memphis, Tennessee, agree in writing to allow DeSoto 29 *SS26/R1354*

County, Mississippi, to remove the safety hazard or contribute 30 funds for the removal of the safety hazard; and 31 (iii) All affected landowners acquiesce to the 32 33 work and give the appropriate Tennessee governmental entity the authority and grant all necessary easements; 34 35 (d) Compensate Tennessee landowners for necessary easements and pay for any damages to a Tennessee landowner's 36 37 property; and (e) Enter into agreements with Tennessee landowners 38 that encompass the scope of the work to be done by DeSoto County 39 40 and any necessary repairs for any damage to the landowner's 41 property.

42 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 43 and after its passage.
