## SENATE BILL NO. 3219 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF
VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRACT FOR NAMING RIGHTS FOR THE
VICKSBURG CONVENTION CENTER AND CITY AUDITORIUM; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of 7 Vicksburg, Mississippi, are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into contracts for the use of a commercial, corporate, 8 9 business or private enterprise name on the building, literature, letterhead or other item, as contracted for, of the Vicksburg 10 Convention Center and City Auditorium. Such contracts shall be 11 for a term that complies with law and, in the discretion of the 12 governing authorities of the City of Vicksburg, may extend beyond 13 the term of office of the persons who are members of the governing 14 authority of the City of Vicksburg when the contract is entered 15 16 into, provided that the maximum term of the contract shall be ten (10) years. Contracts entered into under the provisions of this 17 section shall provide compensation to the City of Vicksburg that 18 19 is fair and adequate consideration, in the determination of the governing authorities of the City of Vicksburg, in exchange for 20 the benefits, name recognition, advertising, potential returns and 21 publicity to the private enterprise. The governing authorities of 22 23 the City of Vicksburg may negotiate and enter into a contract for naming rights, and all incidental rights associated therewith, in 24 the same method as is authorized by law for procuring a contract 25 26 for professional services.

27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 28 and after its passage.
