SENATE BILL NO. 3220

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JEARLINE MOORE OF  
2 BOLIVAR COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Jearline Moore of Bolivar County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction of the crime of grand larceny in Bolivar County,  
8 Mississippi, in 1988, and who was sentenced to serve five (5)  
9 years in the custody of the Department of Corrections. Her  
10 sentence was suspended and she was placed on probation for five  
11 (5) years. Her probation was terminated on August 27, 1993.  
12 Since that time she has conducted herself as a law-abiding and  
13 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
15 and after its passage.
