 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF

 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the

- 9 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 to create a new
- 10 Section ____ to read as follows:
- 11 Section . Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 12 Constitution, the Legislature by statute may determine the limit
- 13 of liability for all damages and losses, however characterized,
- 14 other than economic damages, in any civil claim or cause of
- 15 action. This section applies without regard to whether the claim
- 16 or cause of action arises under or is derived from common law, a
- 17 statute, or other law, including any claim or cause of action
- 18 based or sounding in tort, contract, or any other theory or any
- 19 combination of theories of liability. This section applies to
- 20 laws enacted during the 2002 Third Extraordinary Session and
- 21 during any subsequent regular or special sessions of the
- 22 Legislature.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 24 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 25 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
- of November 2004, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 27 and by general law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
constitutional amendment authorizes the Legislature to determine
the limit of liability for all damages other than economic damages
in civil lawsuits."
