SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 585

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY 2 THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY CERTIFICATE OF NEED
- 3 LAW AND THE STATE HEALTH PLAN IN DESOTO COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AND
- 4 TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON TO THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR
- 5 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 7 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN,
- 8 That:
- 9 (1) There is hereby created a study committee on the
- 10 implementation of the health care facility certificate of need law
- 11 and the State Health Plan by the State Department of Health as it
- 12 specifically applies to DeSoto County, Mississippi. The committee
- 13 shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the
- 14 Legislature during the 2005 Regular Legislative Session, including
- 15 any recommended legislation.
- 16 (2) The committee shall be composed of the following
- 17 members:
- 18 (a) The President Pro Tempore of the Mississippi
- 19 Senate;
- 20 (b) The Speaker Pro Tempore of the Mississippi House of
- 21 Representatives;
- 22 (c) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations
- 23 Committee;
- 24 (d) The Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee;
- 25 (e) The Chairman of the Senate Public Health and
- 26 Welfare Committee;
- 27 (f) The Chairman of the House Public Health and Human
- 28 Services Committee;

The President of the State Board of Health; and 29 (g)30 (h) Two (2) residents of DeSoto County, one (1) 31 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor and one (1) appointed by the 32 Speaker of the House. 33 Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the 34 adoption of this resolution by the Legislature, and, within fifteen (15) days thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by 35 the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the House, the 36 committee shall meet and organize by selecting from its membership 37 a chairman and a vice chairman. The vice chairman shall also 38 39 serve as secretary and shall be responsible for keeping all records of the committee. A majority of the members of the 40 41 committee shall constitute a quorum. In the selection of its officers and the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports, an 42 affirmative vote of a majority of the committee shall be required. 43 All members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, such 44 45 notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior to the date on 46 which a meeting is to be held. The committee shall study and make recommendations with 47 48 respect to the implementation of the health care facility certificate of need law in DeSoto County, Mississippi, including 49 50 procedures used by the State Department of Health in granting and/or denying applications for certificates of need in DeSoto 51 County and the development of the State Health Plan as it relates 52 53 to DeSoto County. Members of the committee who are not legislators, state 54 55 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem rate authorized by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 56 57 shall be reimbursed in accordance with Section 25-3-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, for mileage and actual expenses incurred 58 59 in the performance of their duties. Legislative members of the 60 committee shall be paid from the contingent expense funds of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for committee 61

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- 62 meetings when the Legislature is not in session; however, no per
- 63 diem or expense for attending meetings of the committee will be
- 64 paid while the Legislature is in session. No committee member may
- 65 incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless previously
- 66 authorized by vote, at a meeting of the committee, which action
- 67 shall be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting.
- 68 Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any funds made available
- 69 to the committee for that purpose.
- 70 (5) The committee shall utilize clerical and legal staff
- 71 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance
- 72 made available to it. To effectuate the purpose of this
- 73 resolution, the State Department of Health and any other agency of
- 74 the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the
- 75 request of the chairman of the committee, provide to the committee
- 76 such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the committee
- 77 properly to carry out its task.
- 78 (6) Upon presentation of its report to the 2005 Regular
- 79 Legislative Session, the committee shall be dissolved.
