## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 593

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 BENOIT-RAY BROOKS HIGH SCHOOL "TIGERS" FOR WINNING ITS SECOND  
3 CONSECUTIVE CLASS 1A STATE BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP AND ITS  
4 OUTSTANDING 2003-2004 SEASON.

5 WHEREAS, the Benoit-Ray Brooks High School "Tigers"  
6 Basketball Team won its second consecutive Class 1A State  
7 Championship on Saturday, March 13, 2004, with a thrilling 54-50  
8 victory over Byers High School, before an estimated crowd of 3,500  
9 at the Mississippi Coliseum; Ray Brooks held its ground after  
10 Byers mounted a furious comeback attempt during the final quarter;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Ray Brooks High School is the smallest school in the  
13 State of Mississippi, with an enrollment of under 300 students,  
14 and with this victory, the student body and the community of  
15 Benoit went home with back-to-back championships to call their  
16 own; and

17 WHEREAS, Ray Brooks High School, which completed this  
18 outstanding season with a record of 23-9 is only in its third year  
19 of existence; originally, the students in Benoit attended West  
20 Bolivar in Rosedale, but these students have a new school to  
21 attend and another championship to celebrate as their own; and

22 WHEREAS, on their way to the State Championship, the Ray  
23 Brooks Tigers won their District Championship and the Class 1A  
24 South-Half Title; and

25 WHEREAS, the Tigers were a very physical team, ably coached  
26 by Head Coach S.C. Cannon and Assistant Coaches Dexter Bryant,  
27 Jerry Walker, Terry Leonard and Peris Leonard; and

28           WHEREAS, Senior Guard James Giles (who was awarded prior to  
29 the championship game the coveted and prestigious "Big Dog" Award  
30 by the Mississippi National Guard), Junior Guard Jimmie Kimble and  
31 Senior Forward Jeffrey Phillips were named to the All-Tournament  
32 Team; and

33           WHEREAS, the 2004 roster of this championship team is as  
34 follows: #14 Christopher Brooks, #11 Elliott Davis, #55 Adrian  
35 Dillard, #5 James Giles, #32 Lavarus Giles, #20 Corderro Ireland,  
36 #22 Jimmy Kimble, #00 Damien Leslie, #10 David Leslie, #12 Wayne  
37 Leslie, #4 Travis McGee, #21 Eric Nelson, #3 Kozialski Nelson, #15  
38 Jeffrey Phillips, Johnny Lewis - Manager, Lorenzo Thomas -  
39 Manager, Anthony Rivera - Manager, Teela Rivera - Bookkeeper; and

40           WHEREAS, according to the players that made it happen,  
41 capturing the school's second straight State Title was all a  
42 matter of having faith in each other; and

43           WHEREAS, it is with pride that we recognize the special  
44 accomplishments of this team which brought honor and identity to  
45 their school, their community and to the State of Mississippi:

46           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
47 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
48 we do hereby commend and congratulate the Benoit-Ray Brooks High  
49 School "Tigers" Basketball Team, Head Coach S.C. Cannon, Principal  
50 Barbara C. Akon, Superintendent Dr. Suzanne Hawley and Associate  
51 Superintendent Sherry Shepard for their second consecutive State  
52 Class 1A Championship and their outstanding 2003-2004 season, and  
53 extend to them the best wishes of the Legislature for future  
54 scholastic and athletic successes.

56 Coach Cannon and the team and the Principal of Benoit-Ray Brooks
