SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 602

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CAREER AND CIVIC 1 CONTRIBUTIONS OF FRED CARL, JR., OF GREENWOOD, MISSISSIPPI, 2 PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF VIKING RANGE CORPORATION. 3 4 WHEREAS, when the leaders of industry and economic 5 development in the Mississippi Delta are mentioned, the name Fred Carl, Jr., is first on the list; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Fred Carl, Jr., is a native of Greenwood, 8 Mississippi, and attended Mississippi State University. He has a

9 Bachelor of Business Administration Degree from Delta State 10 University in Cleveland, Mississippi, and also attended graduate 11 school in City Planning at the University of Mississippi; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Carl is the founder and Chairman, President and 13 Chief Executive Officer of Viking Range Corporation, an industry leading manufacturer of upscale kitchen appliances for the home, 14 15 which serves the North American market, as well as over 70 other countries throughout the world. Prior to founding Viking, Mr. 16 17 Carl was a fourth generation building contractor, having been a 18 design/build general contractor throughout his entire adult career. Mr. Carl is a member of the National Kitchen & Bath 19 20 Association Hall of Fame and was selected as the Mid-South 21 Entrepreneur of the Year in 1996. He is a member of the Advisory 22 Board of Directors of Trustmark National Bank of Greenwood, 23 Mississippi; and

24 WHEREAS, in the late 1970s Mr. Carl noticed that more and 25 more upscale consumers, and especially celebrities and serious 26 gourmets, were installing commercial restaurant ranges in the 27 kitchens of their homes. When Mr. Carl and his wife, Margaret,

wanted one of these for their own kitchen, Carl quickly realized 28 29 that true restaurant ranges were not suitable for home use due to 30 many factors such as high heat output and poor insulation, so Carl designed a range that solved these problems yet retained the 31 32 heavy-duty cooking power of its commercial counterpart. He 33 founded Viking Range Corporation in 1984 to manufacture and 34 distribute the product, and Carl shipped his first Viking range in January 1987. Seventeen years later, Viking continues to be the 35 leader in this segment of the United States major appliance 36 37 industry as the only manufacturer of a complete line of ultra-premium, commercial-style appliances for the home. 38 Carl's company sells to every state in the United States through an 39 40 extensive distributor network, and Viking products have been sold 41 in over 70 international countries; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carl's civic contributions are a matter of 42 record: He serves on the Executive Committee of the Board of 43 44 Directors of the Mississippi State University Foundation, the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of the Mississippi 45 Partnership for Economic Development, the Board of Directors of 46 47 the Greenwood-Leflore County Economic Development Foundation, and 48 is a member of the Governor's State Summit on Higher Education. 49 Mr. Carl also serves on the Advisory Board of the School of Architecture, the Small Town Center Board and the Advisory Board 50 of the College of Business and Industry at Mississippi State 51 52 University. Mr. Carl served as the Chairman of the first Mississippi Blues Commission, appointed by Governor Musgrove in 53 54 December 2003. The Alluvian, formerly the historic Hotel Irving 55 in Greenwood, was one of Mississippi's most endangered buildings until Fred Carl, Jr., decided to preserve the building and 56 revitalize the property. In the Greenwood/Leflore County 57 58 Community, Fred is a member of Greenwood/Leflore Industrial Board, 59 a member of the Trustmark Board of Directors, Past-President of the Greenwood Country Club and a member of the Vestry of the 60 *SS02/R1397* S. Episcopal Church of the Nativity. He was recently named to the Leflore County Hall of Fame and the Mississippi Business Hall of Fame. Mr. Carl and his wife, Margaret, have one son, Chris, age 24, who is employed by one of the Viking subsidiaries; and
