## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 614

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 JACKSON "SENATORS" PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THE 2003  
3 CENTRAL BASEBALL LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR THEIR ACCOMPLISHMENTS  
4 AT SMITH-WILLS STADIUM.

6 baseball and utilizing a wide variety of fun and imaginative  
7 promotions, the Jackson "Senators" Professional Baseball Team has  
8 achieved success at Smith-Wills Stadium in Jackson, Mississippi;

11 Eastern Division Pennants in 2002 and 2003, the Jackson Senators

19 the Mets, the Generals and the Diamond Kats as Jackson

- 28 • 2003 average attendance, 1,991 fans per game;

- 29       • Placed 9 players into affiliated baseball;
- 30       • Built Left Field Sports Grill, a fully operational on-site
- 31       restaurant open year round;
- 32       • Host major college baseball games, including the Mayor's
- 33       Trophy between the University of Mississippi and Mississippi
- 34       State University;
- 35       • Host high school state playoff games and all-star events;
