SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 19

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING GRADUATE DEANS FROM JACKSON STATE  
2 UNIVERSITY WHO HAVE PROVIDED FIFTY YEARS OF EXEMPLARY SERVICE.

3 WHEREAS, the following persons, the late Dr. Augustus C.  
4 Blanks, Dr. Charles C. Mosley and Dr. Ivory C. Manning, Dr. Oscar  
5 Allan Rogers, Dr. Leslie Burl McLemore, Dr. Bettye Ward-Fletcher,  
6 Dr. Lula S. Collier, Dr. E.C. Foster, Dr. Dorris R.  
7 Robinson-Gardner and Dr. Jeffrey D. Zubkowski, have provided  
8 exemplary service to Jackson State University in the development  
9 of excellence in graduate education during the past fifty years

24 propelled from its roots as a regional teacher's college to the  
25 doctoral research intensive university it is today; and

26 WHEREAS, it is because of the immeasurable contributions of  
27 such educators that Jackson State University, with a longstanding

28 tradition of dedicated educators, will continue to grow and reach  
29 greater vitality; and

30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Senate of the State of  
31 Mississippi to recognize and commend excellence and the  
32 exceptional contributions to the field of graduate education in  
33 higher learning, especially when evidenced by people who have  
34 dedicated so many years of their lives to developing and  
35 cultivating the minds and bodies of the many young scholars and  
36 professionals with whom they come in contact during their careers:
