- 20 WHEREAS, M.T. Parker played an instrumental part in writing
- 21 the Tractor and Plow Safety (TAPS) Manual; and
- 22 WHEREAS, he has made thousands of presentations to fire
- 23 department personnel, forest industries, civic organizations,
- 24 schools and even made door-to-door calls in high-risk areas to
- 25 stress the need for wildfire prevention; and
